The happening takes place on the occasion of the **Rehabilitation in Multiple Sclerosis 2026 conference**, an international professional conference focused on the rehabilitation of people with Multiple Sclerosis, held 10–13 June 2026 in Prague. The main local organizers are the Third Faculty of Medicine, Charles University and the University Hospital Královské Vinohrady.

The event **“Moving Together”** connects the morning and afternoon professional program organized by the Third Faculty of Medicine (registration is open until 31 May on the conference website).

4 Workshops 9:00–11:30 h – A practical overview of neurorehabilitation methods, including the Bobath concept, digital biomarkers, neuromodulation techniques, and innovative virtual reality for upper limb rehabilitation based on principles of proprioceptive facilitation and inhibition.

3 courses 13:00–15:00 h – Implementation of the International Classification of Functioning, Disability and Health (ICF) into clinical practice for people with Multiple Sclerosis. • Possibilities of applying the Vojta Method in people with MS • Rehabilitation approaches for individuals with severe disability (course fee: 60 EUR)
